



Skirmish High Wycombe Paintball Safety Guidelines

Experience

Skirmish High Wycombe was founded in 2002 and has built an excellent reputation for quality entertainment in a safe environment and for the health and safety of all participants. Skirmish High Wycombe is an accredited member of the United Kingdom Paintball Sports Federation, the sport's governing body. The Skirmish Directors & Management team have in excess of 45 years experience of working in the paintball industry.

Location and Amenities

Skirmish is situated on Fryers Farm Lane, High Wycombe; it has large woodland playing areas which are free from potential hazards and clear of public rights of way. Situated next to the main access road is the Safe Zone. This enclosed area is surrounded by 3 metre high pellet proof netting and paintball markers are always kept outside this area, so participants can safely walk around without wearing their safety equipment. Situated within the safe zone is the Administration Office, Coffee Shop, Breakfast & Burger Bar, Stores, First Aid, Toilets, and Kitchen, where food is prepared in compliance with Environmental Health guidelines.

Staff

All games take place within daylight hours and are marshalled by fully trained site personnel on a ratio of approximately one marshal to fifteen players which follows UKPSF guidelines. The marshals are clearly visible in site uniform and at each event there is at least one marshal who has St John's Ambulance First Aid Training.

Briefing

Prior to the commencement of the games a comprehensive introduction and safety briefing is given to all participants. This includes instruction on the safe use of all equipment with important emphasis on eye and ear protection, (goggle wearing, cleaning & adjustment procedures etc.) the rules of the game, a description of the geography of the site and an introduction to the site staff.

Equipment

The equipment provided to participants is of the highest standards. All players are given goggles with integral face & ear protection. All equipment is checked and serviced weekly. All paintball markers are chronographed regularly and set at approximately 270 feet per second. The kinetic energy of the paintballs will not exceed 12 ft pounds. The contents of the paintballs are non-toxic, biodegradable and non-irritant.
